

The Davenport and Vinton Lutheran Home campuses is committed to transparency and will notify residents, resident representatives and families when a resident or staff member in their facility has a single laboratory confirmed infection of COVID-19, or three or more residents or staff with new-onset of respiratory symptoms, occurring within 72 hours of each other. Please note that respiratory symptoms are tracked through our daily monitoring protocol for residents and staff; and may or may not be confirmed as coronavirus.

The current status is that we have NO confirmed cases of COVID-19 at our Lutheran Home campuses in Davenport or Vinton.

Below is a chart showing the cumulative data of positive COVID-19 cases and respiratory symptom cases as of **October 13, 2020**. Please feel free to contact the appropriate Administrator if you have any questions concerning the data impacting your loved one.

Based on guidance from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and the Center for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS), we continue to utilize the following steps to reduce the spread and impact of COVID-19:
